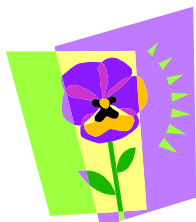
Dear Delta Sisters,

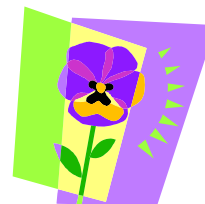
I am looking forward to seeing all of you here for the Pansy Salad Supper we have such a diverse group of women it is a privilege to be your president for the third time.

South Bay Panhellenic -	18.00

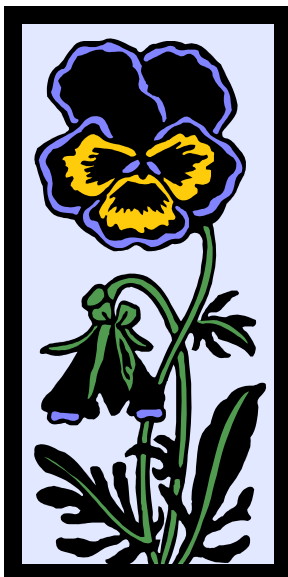
In addition to this, we paid required dues to National of \$450.00, and will finance our president's trip to the Chicago convention in July.
